



ECH's nationally-recognized residential treatment program is licensed to provide intensive, full-time care for young people ages six to 18. Youth receive individual, group, and family counseling as well as case management and psychiatric services. During their stay with us, they find a safe place to address their unique challenges and learn skills that can help them return to family and community life.

ECH's Home and Community-Based Services are available in St. Louis, Jefferson City, Union, and Poplar Bluff to assist families during their most difficult moments. Family Solutions for Kids is an in-home program that helps the whole family learn new ways to address problems and relate to one another. The Foster Care Case Management team works with families by providing them with the tools and support needed for a happy, healthy future. Outpatient Psychiatry offers access to crucial behavioral health services that are in otherwise short supply.
